


DP200 SIDE

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




DP201 EFES

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


DP203 PERGE




DP204 SMIRNA




DP208 ARTEMIS


DP213 HITIT




DP214 SUMELA






DP215 OLYMPOS






DP216 SARA






DP217 PATRAS


It is the third largest city in Greece after Athens and Thessaloniki. Its name was Balyabadra during the Ottoman period.
